New in Pro Series 7.0 Build 3000!

This release of Pro Series 7.0 features **SQL Server 2000**! See your Installation Guide for information on [“Installing Pro Series with SQL Server 2000”](#) and [“Converting to SQL Server 2000”](#).

Pro Series 7.0 allows users to have multiple screens open across applications. Users can open numerous transaction and maintenance screens at the same time, allowing them to multi-task and increase efficiency. For more information on MDI forms, see [“Using MDI Forms” on page 11](#) of your User Guide.

Picklists are more user-friendly than ever! Each picklist is now a DataDriller data view providing users with the ability to sort on column, apply filters, and run data searches. See [“Selecting Picklist Values” on page 21](#) of your User Guide. Picklists can also be customized for an individual user ID using the **Copy From** option in DataDriller. For complete instructions, see [“Copying a Data View” on page 167](#) in System Manager.

Sort DataDriller data views by clicking the column header. Now users have the ability to filter and sort data views instantly. For more information on working with DataDriller data views, see [“Using DataDriller” on page 50](#) of your User Guide.

Use the **Advanced** options on the DataDriller - Define Columns screen to apply formatting rules (**UDFs**) for display in DataDriller pick lists and data views, or conditionally hide or show **DataDriller** data view columns based on an expression evaluated at run time. See [“Setting Up DataDriller Data Views” on page 141](#) of your System Manager documentation.

Apply formats to filter expressions using the **Filter Format** field in the DataDriller - Define Columns screen. See [“DataDriller Define - Columns \(Detail\) Fields” on page 158](#) of your System Manager documentation.

For Pro Series 7.0, System Manager’s Data Dictionary Stored Procedures have been separated into procedures and **SQL User-Defined Functions (UDFs)**. See [“User Defined Functions” on page 324](#) for more information.

Use System Manager utilities to rebuild your **Stored Procedures** and **User Defined Functions**. See [“Rebuilding Stored Procedures” on page 209](#) and [“Rebuilding User Defined Functions” on page 211](#) in your System Manager documentation.

Use the **Favorites** toolbar to create desktop icons for frequently-used screens. Clicking a Favorite desktop icon provides instant access to screens (such as Enter Payables, or Enter Orders). The toolbar and menu options allow you to add, organize, and view Favorites. For more information, go to [“Toolbars” on page 39](#) of your User Guide.

Users can now **display or print orders from history**. You now have the choice of printing/displaying current orders, or orders that have been moved to history. See [“Printing or Viewing From History” on page 278](#) in your Accounts Receivable documentation, [“Printing or Viewing From History” on page 231](#) of your Order Entry documentation, or [“Printing or Viewing From History” on page 175](#) of your Purchase Order documentation.

A new **Print Range** button has been added to the Print dialog box, enabling users to select the range of pages to be printed for a report. See the “Printing or Exporting Reports” section in the “Reports” chapter of any application documentation.

The privileges **SOPOSTO2** and **POPOSTO2** have been added to allow users to enter bids in Order Entry and Purchase Orders. See the [“Process ID List” on page 443](#) of your System Manager documentation, or [“Assigning Privileges” on page 131](#) for information on adding user privileges.
